FAMILY BEACH DAY



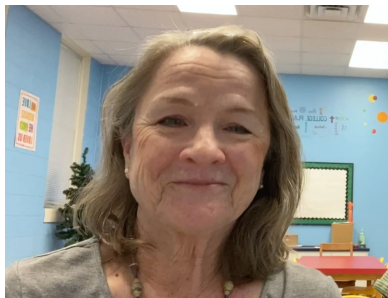
