Time to Honor an Unsung Hero

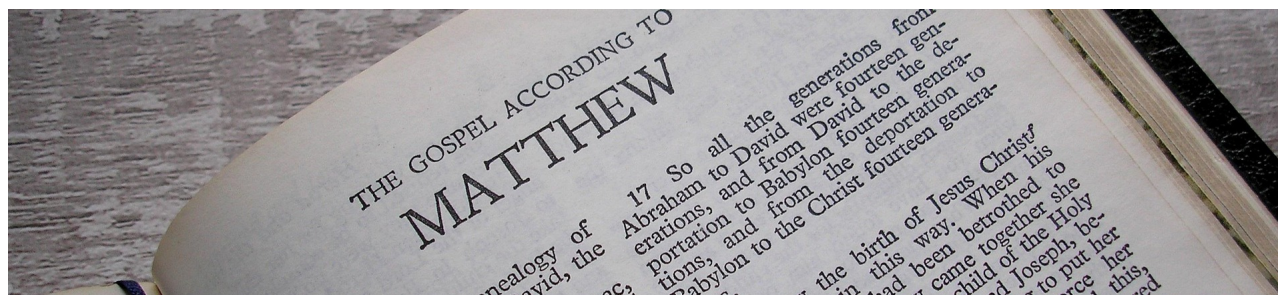

Submissions should include reasons for the nomination, such as: This person is always around assisting with various projects at the church, like fixing toilets, changing light bulbs, cleaning up spills or stains, setting up/taking down tables for dinners or services, weeding, power washing, replacing ceiling tiles, etc. Recent winners have included Earl Buckner and Judy Chambless.
